THE ST. IVES COMMUNITY CHOIR ACCOUNTS 2014 REPORT

- We started 2014 with £1,808.30.
- Thanks to Jenny's World War II Play and your support with buying tickets we raised £586.33 after expenses. £300 of that was donated to The Chernobyl Children. Together with the funds raised at The Fore Street Concert, this brings the total donation to The Chernobyl Children to £850.27.
- We paid out £178.09 for Public Liability and Keyboard insurances and our Website Domain Registration.
- Superact paid us £400 for Our Big Gig at Trewyn Gardens and collection buckets raised another £41.50 which left us with a profit of £396.50 after expenses.
- Lynne and Noel kindly hosted a social evening which raised £33.
- We had a donation of £25 from Trengwainton.
- The collection at Barclays Bank was £20.79.
- Purchase and replacement of music has cost £35.40.
- Rent for the Chapel has been £480.
- £1,075.30 was paid in subscriptions.
- £200 was donated by the family as a thank you for the choir singing at the 70th wedding anniversary. This will be included in the 2015 accounts.
- The total amount we have raised for charities via concerts is over £2,500.
- The final total in the bank to start 2015 is £2,739.73.
